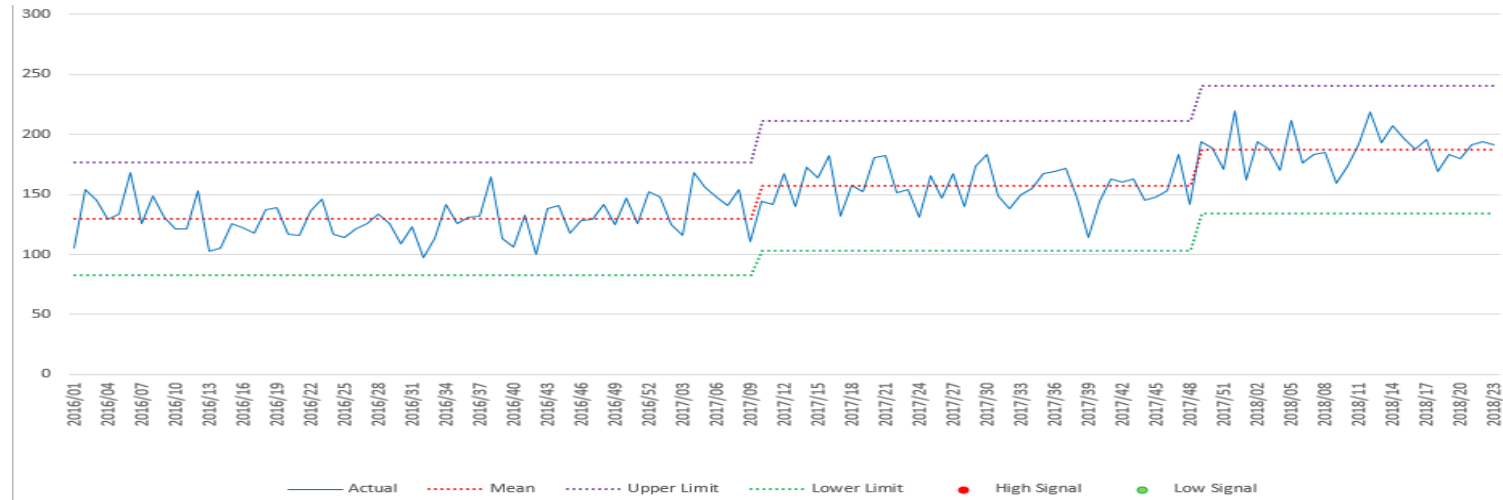

- Supporting vulnerable households e.g. fire safety checks

Performance



- » Victim based crimes increased in Flintshire by 16% in 2017/18, but the Local Authority that experienced the smallest rise in North Wales.
- » Recorded ASB levels in Flintshire are lower in 2018/19 when compared to previous years. Repeat victims, locations and high risk vulnerable victims are referred for review to a multi-agency tasking group (Community Demand Reduction Partnership).
