▶ **Biggest Challenge**

- ▶ Already lots of Environment work going on, but how do we open and share this work with other groups and sectors
- ▶ How do we raise awareness by protecting and enhancing the environment this will support Health and Wellbeing and Economics within our communities
- ▶ Climate and Nature Emergency will have long term impacts on our communities and how do we prevent and adapt our communities to be resilient

▶ **What we've achieved**

- ▶ Bringing different partners together such as 3rd Sectors Groundwork, NWWT, Transport for Wales, PHW, WG Energy Sector, NRW, Flintshire and Wrexham, AONB
- ▶ Mapped out the work that partners are doing and seeing links between our works and any opportunities to link up
- ▶ Integrating the 'Environment' theme across and within other themes such as poverty and inequality

Opportunities that we have:

- ▶ Limit the negative impacts on our Green spaces such as traffic/litter/fly tipping and behaviours
- ▶ Integrate Environmental Services into other groups, raise awareness of benefits to Health and wellbeing and enhancing green spaces. Through Social Prescribing, volunteers and areas that other groups identified to work in collaboration
- ▶ **Carbon Reduction**
 - ▶ Travel and how do we change behaviours – Active Travel Charter
 - ▶ Joint groups with partners and different sectors to learn and share information
 - ▶ Raise awareness of Climate Change within organisations and with communities and bringing them on this journey – link in with Children’s University
 - ▶ Impact of food miles and food waste and link with food poverty
- ▶ **Care and Repair, Shotton**
 - ▶ Support with creation of community woodland and enhance biodiversity
 - ▶ Support with safe access for the local community to use the space
 - ▶ Support the community to identify how they want to develop the space
- ▶ **Wrexham Forests**
 - ▶ Develop this idea that could be expanded to Flintshire
- ▶ **Moel Famau Uplands Project**
 - ▶ Collaborative project with Flintshire and NRW
