I am writing to you in connection with the Planning Application for the above business.

I do apologise most sincerely if this letter, rather than an e-mail, causes you or your department extra work. There are difficulties with my present, and new, laptop, and I feel that for such an important application, accuracy is essential.

Personally I support this application. In my opinion Hendre Quarry is a well run business. In particular the staff make every effort to minimise any inconvenience to the general public, such as using a special vehicle which sprays the road from the Quarry up to Rhydymyn village to dampen down the inevitable dust caused by outgoing Lorries. Blasting in the quarry is kept well within the legal maximum of noise and reverberation. When possible the staff support local activities with special attendance to the welfare of the environment. Plans are in hand to cut down completely the use of diesel powered machinery and vehicles, thus lowering radically carbon emissions.

Unlike other quarries in Halbryn Ward I have received no complaints from the local community. In a small way I am informed that the quarry staff support local businesses.

Even if it were possible for me to participate in a "Zoom" style of meeting I have nothing to ^{add to} what is already written and I doubt if any speech of mine could be of further use to the actual, live discussion.
